Getting set up on your pitch

For fire safety reasons, please ensure your van/tent/motor home is pitched within your allocated site and that the back right or offside corner is within 1m of the white pitch marker post. (See pitch map for further details.)

After pitching up, and again for safety reasons, we ask you to move your car/vehicle to the car park for the duration of your stay. Please do not join together 2 or more power cables as it is a fire hazard.

Dress code

Broadlands is a naturist club, not clothes optional, therefore nudity is required whenever the weather allows.

Arrival / Departure

Please arrive between 14:00 and 18:00. Late arrivals by special arrangement only.

We ask you to vacate your pitch by 11:00 (unless prior arrangement is made with the Warden). Entry and exit is by key card to operate the gate. On final departure please leave your card in the grey box under the card reader.

Shower blocks and toilets

There are two shower blocks with toilets. These are cleaned regularly. The block by the Clubhouse has a separate disabled shower/toilet.

Please leave all areas as you wish to find them and please do not use the sinks for washing up.

Washing up and Laundry

Dish washing facilities are provided but please use hot water sparingly. There are washing machines/dryers provided at a small charge. Please keep this area tidy and clean.

Drinking water and water disposal

Drinking water taps are situated around the camping areas (see site map).

There are two Elsan points for black water disposal located near each shower block. Grey water disposal is via a drain beside Shower block 2 (Top shower block).

Recycling and waste disposal

Please place waste items in the correct bins (flatten boxes and bottles) and recycle whenever possible. See the information posted at the bin store for the type of items accepted.

Appliances, electrical items, larger items etc must not be left here but should be taken to the nearby South Norfolk Council recycling centre.

Wifi

Free Wifi is available on site, and log in details can be obtained from the Reception or on a sign by the door. Please note the due to our rural location bandwidth and speed are limited.

Music/radios/noise

Music / radios etc may not be played on the sun green. In other places please be considerate to others.

Site Rules

We have a few necessary rules to make everyone's stay as enjoyable as possible:

- Do not light ground fires. Raised BBQs / firepits are allowed with caution especially during dry weather. Please leave the camping area as you found it.
- Do not smoke or vape in the toilet blocks, cafe, clubhouse and other public areas.
- Photography of any kind (including dash cams) is prohibited at any time.
- Please adhere to our health and safety requests which are designed to keep everyone safe and well. (see *Safety First* overleaf)

Swimming pool

Swimming costumes are not permitted to be worn in the pool. A minimum of 2 adults must be in the pool house when swimming and children should be supervised at all times. Details of all the safety rules are posted in the pool area.

Sauna

There must be at least two adults in the sauna at any time. The sauna is operated by £1 coins

Naturist Woodland / Dog walk

Our naturist circular walk (approx ¾ mile) can be accessed at various points including close to the entrance gate. Ideal for a relaxing walk with your dog.

Fishing lake

The lake may be used for fishing at any time with barbless hooks. Please ensure you leave it clean and tidy. Swimming is strictly prohibited.

Visitor hut

This is next to the reception and day visitors are welcome to use this. There are several lockers available for day use.

"Honesty cafe"

We have an honesty cafe with ice creams, teas, coffees and soft drinks.

There are freezers for use by campers at the rear of the clubhouse. Please use clearly labelled bags and pay £1 per bag at reception to help with running costs.

Please note, animals are **not** permitted, on the sunbathing green, in or around the clubhouse or shower/toilet blocks. (Not applicable to assistance dogs).

The Clubhouse

Check the notice board for details of events. Evening events in the clubhouse are usually textile but this is not compulsory and you may be naked if you wish.

Visitors are welcome to make use of the pool table, table tennis, darts and card games and the TV room. Children must be supervised at all times in the clubhouse and TV room.
